



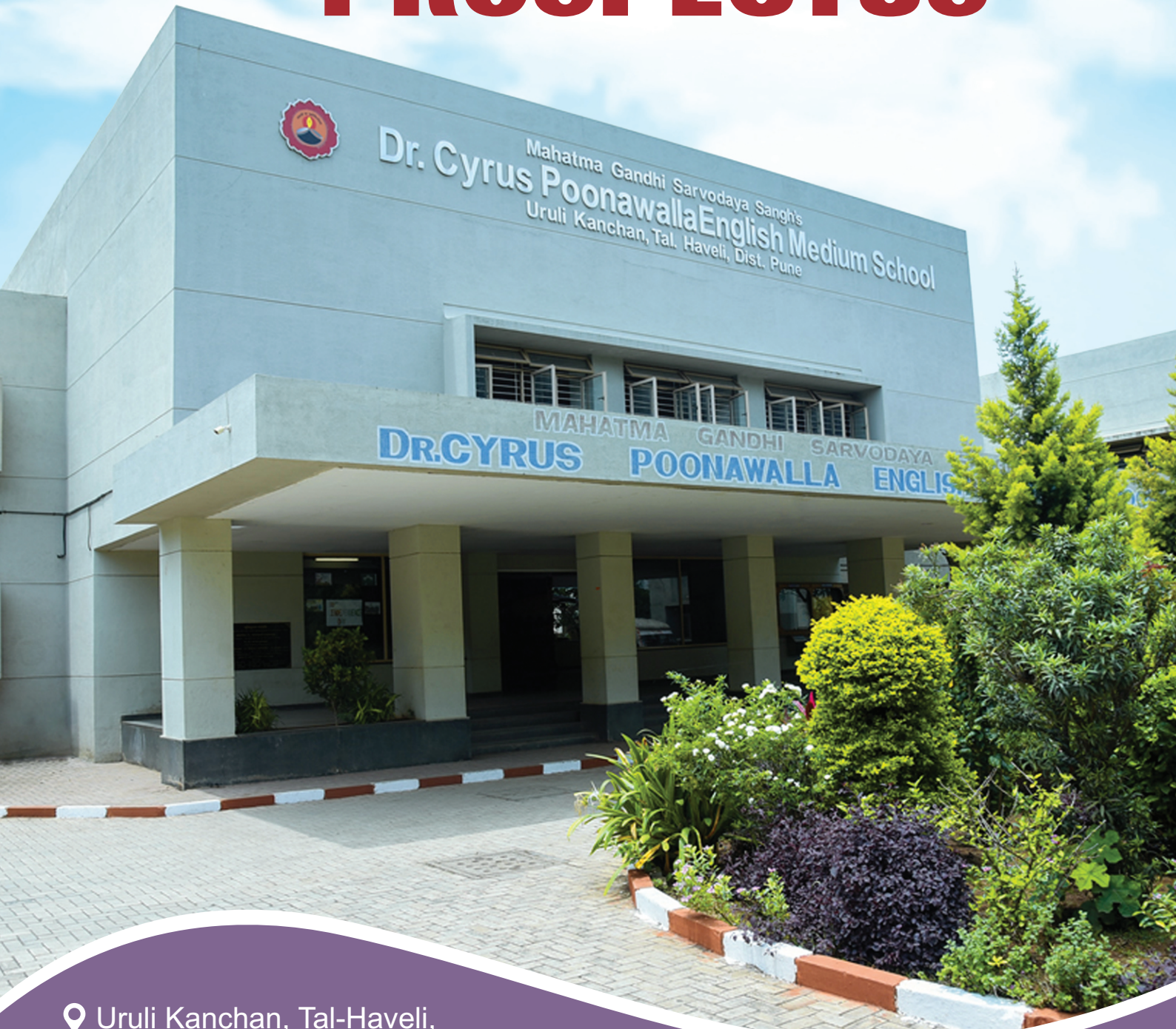

ADMISSION PROCESS

- Please go through the Prospectus carefully
- Please fill in the Admission Form given to you by the school carefully and correctly. Incomplete forms will not be accepted.
- The applications will be vetted by the concerned officials of the Admission Committee at the school office. Final Decision will be taken by the Principal.
- While the admissions at the Nursery, L.K.G. and U.K.G. and Std. I parents should submit original birth certificate, of recognized Grampanchayat, Nagar Parishad, Municipal corporation.
- For Admission to Std. II and above Leaving Certificate and Progress Card of their In case the Previous school is required.
- In case student's previous school is outside the district / state, the leaving certificate has to be counter signed by the education department of the concerned district/state.
- For L.K.G. and U.K.G. admissions, the school believes in equal opportunities for all and does not discriminate between gender, language, class, caste, religion, or locality. Admission for all classes from Std II and above are based on Merit only.
- Incorrect, Incomplete forms and the late forms will not be considered for admission.
- After obtaining signature from the concerned official of the Admission Committee on the admission form, the student has to pay the full fees prescribed by school. If the fees is not paid the admission can stand cancelled.
- Please keep safe current Receipt of Fees paid, as it is required at various points in the academic year.
Fee should be paid one time on or before 15 of April.
- If any student is moving in middle of academic year they have to pay full fee.
- If any parent need any certificate from school they have to submit application before one week with GR No.

Age Criteria

Nur.: 3 Years to 3 ½ Years

LkG.: 3 Years to 4 ½ Years

UKG.: 4 Years to 5 ½ Years

Std. I : 5 Years to 6 ½ Years

The school records will accept the spelling and format of the name/surname/father's name and mother's name as it appears in the birth certificate / leaving certificate. It is the responsibility of the parents to produce the required legal document like Court Order before the education department and get their written consent for the name change.

REGISTRATION FOR ADMISSION

The following documents are essential for determining eligibility of the registration and should be attached with the form -

Documents required:

1. Photocopy of Birth Certificate
2. Mark Sheet / Grade Certificate of previous class (In Case of Class II and above only)
3. Electricity/Telephone (Landline only) latest bill in original.
4. Attested copy of caste certificate issued by the concerned authorities.
5. Six recent photographs of the child/ Aadhar card copies / fitness / blood group. (The original documents to be produced for verification at the time of submission of form.)
6. Pass certificate of X
7. Migration certificate of X

WITHDRAWAL

For Cancellation of admission under any reason please apply to The Principal within 10 days from the date of admission in prescribed format and signed by parents. The Principal will consider the application on merit.

For cancelling admission, the fees WILL NOT BE REFUNDED. For school leaving certificate the application should be submitted to the school authority on or before 15th Feb. School leaving certificate will be given to the parents only.

SCHOOL ADMINISTRATION

Office Timings

The school office functions from 8.30 a.m. to 12.30 p.m. and from 2.00 p.m. to 4.00 p.m. on all working days from Monday to Friday. On Saturdays the school office functions from 8.30 a.m. to 12.30 p.m.

Fees

- As the school runs on non-aided base the staff salaries and establishment expenses of the school are met entirely from the fees collected, it becomes very difficult for the school to function properly if the fees are not paid in time
- Leaving certificates or Examination reports will be given only to those who have cleared all their dues.
- Mode of Payment Fees are to be paid by Bank-challan or online only. Please ensure that proper receipt is obtained from the school office for the payment remitted.

The timing for meeting the Principal is only on Saturday after the school. Parents are not permitted to meet the teachers during school hours. They can meet the teachers on.

Senior Secondary	: Saturday after the school.

Parents must make it a habit to meet the Principal / Teachers regularly. (At least twice a month) to know the progress of their child.

DISCIPLINE

Following rules will be strictly obeyed by the students -

- The uniform of the Student should be clean and neat. The school uniform is to be worn every day.
- All students are expected to arrive in the school on time.
- Students are expected to respect school property and communicate in English in the school premises.
- In case of illness, unforeseen or unavoidable circumstances, a letter to that effect requesting leave of absence must be sent to the school office.
- The school is not responsible for the safe custody of the children after school hours.
- No student is allowed to leave the school premises during school hours, including short and long recesses, strict disciplinary action will be taken against defaulter.
- No student is allowed to bring to school any object such as toys, blades, pen-knives, sharp instruments or things that could harm, liable to prove sources of disturbance and danger.
- No student should be absent without previously obtained leave. Leave must be obtained by a previous written application to be made in the prescribed leave record in the calendar.
- Repeated absence for feasts, wedding etc renders the student liable to be struck off the roll various points in the academic year.



INFRASTRUCTURE
