Infrastructure Up gradation-

- The school was established in 2010 and is running through its 13th successful year. The School Building has well developed spacious 46 Classrooms, including extension to accommodate the senior students with 71 Total room and 6 Laboratories for preparing for senior secondary students by providing a positive and supportive learning environment.
- To encourage reading habit among children, a splendid existing Library has been enriched with a rich collection of additional couple of thousand books pertaining to academics as well as competitive preparations, journals, Subject Magazines and Reference materials is maintained on a regular basis.
- To enhance practical knowledge of the students, the existing lab was upgraded and dedicated Physics, Chemistry and Biology Laboratories are developed in the campus where in students gain hands on experience on the subjects taught in the classrooms (III TO XII STD).

- The status of the Sports Infrastructure of the campus like the Basketball Court, Table Tennis and Kho-Kho are maintained providing exciting possibilities to the students to develop their sportive skills. Football ground is being constructed for aiding the requirements of the sports enthusiasts.
- A spacious and airy Assembly hall with a space of 100 seating capacity is maintained for students to dine. The teachers check the food quality at a regular basis and guide the students to follow a healthy diet.
- School has an Indoor Seminar Hall for accommodating over 300 students. It is used for organizing many events and activities. Science Lab Report

A laboratory is a facility that provides controlled conditions in which scientific or technological research, experiments & measurement may be performed. A laboratory school is a facility where teachers, students, and families can learn about child development and education. They observe children interacting with one another with adults, with various materials, and with queries and new concepts they encounter daily. School labs are an excellent place for the student, which help them enhance their learning by understanding the theoretical concepts of science taught in the classroom. Well-designed laboratories make science experiments fun and help students achieve good academic results. I, Zhohera Mulani, work as a lab In charge in Dr. Cyrus Poonawala English Medium School. I arranged the science practical's in labs like the Physics lab, Chemistry lab & Biology Lab. As per the mid-term syllabus, I arranged the practical from STD III to XII Std this academic year (2022-23). All practical are completed very smoothly from Std III to XII. Subject teacher during their science period used to bring the student in discipline manner in the laboratory as per sub, like chemistry, physics & Biology. Many experiments students have done manually in 11th & 12th classes under the observation of lab In charge & teacher. Laboratory safety measures like a fire extinguisher and exhaust fan for smaller classes have safety measures. Teachers have demonstrated experiments in class 9th & 10th students made temporary slides of plant cells, stomata, etc. some practical are based on spotting & observation skills. All students involved in practical enthusiastically, everyone is interested & like to do the practical. All students maintain practical journals & teachers also maintain the record. All required equipment & material have been available in the laboratory for the last two years. CBSE Board practical exam was conducted systematically. Twice a week, we conduct 11th & 12th Std practical. Students are doing project work also. Including titration salt analysis, functional group detection, and taking of melting point & boiling point practical. Students are doing all of this in a chemistry lab. More than 375 practical's are done in all labs from Std III to XII Std.
